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

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §480-I, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Annual report. The commissioner and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall jointly make an annual report on or before January 1st to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resource matters on the progress of the mapping of significant wildlife habitats.
