SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1095, L.D. 1538, Bill, "An Act to Promote Adult Education"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds to increase the state subsidy for adult education by 2% in fiscal year 1998-99.

This amendment provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Education of \$72,210 in fiscal year 1998-99 to increase the adult education subsidy by 2% in fiscal year 1998-99. This reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$72,210 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$110,482 in fiscal year 1998-99.

This amendment replaces the committee amendment which required that the state subsidy for adult education be increased in proportion to any increase provided to General Purpose Aid to Local Schools and provided General Fund appropriations representing 2% and 3% increases in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. This amendment instead provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Education's Learning Systems account in order to increase the adult education subsidy 2% in fiscal year 1998-99.
