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This bill authorizes the Department of Education to develop standardized construction plans and to choose school plans for new school construction that take the school's 5-year target population into consideration. The bill requires the department to develop a process for choosing the plans in a timely manner and requires any changes to the plans requested by a local school administrative unit to be the responsibility of the local unit.
