6	10. Training in firearm safety.
8	A. The commissioner shall establish a program for training individuals in the safe handling of firearms and for this
10	purpose may cooperate with any public or private association or organization having as one of its objectives the
12	promotion of safety in firearms handling.
14	B. In establishing the program the commissioner shall:
16	(1) Prescribe the qualifications of instructors. Each instructor authorized by the commissioner to conduct
18	these programs shall <u>must</u> be covered by liability insurance protecting him the instructor from liability
20	for damages during the time when instruction is being qiven. The cost of this insurance shall-be is borne by
22	the State and shall-be <u>is</u> a charge against the funds credited to the department;

26	(2) Prescribe the type and course of instruction and the time and place of examinations; and
28	(3) Issue a certificate of competency to individuals who successfully complete the examination.
