Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:

F. A holder of a small brewery license may offer its malt beverages to licensed retailers for the purposes of taste testing the product. Twenty-four hour notice must be given to the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages indicating the location, amount and brands to be offered as samples. The taste testing of malt beverages may not exceed 5 gallons per brand per retail license year. Any taste testing must be in accordance with section 1402, subsection 3, except that paragraph D does not apply.

SUMMARY

18 This bill allows the holder of a brewery license or small brewery license to offer its malt beverages to licensed retailers 20 for the purposes of taste testing the product. Current law allows one license at one location.
