Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6039 is enacted to read:

§6039. Advance rent; prohibition

A landlord may not collect rent more than 3 months in 8 advance of the rental period for which the rent is due. For purposes of this section, a rental period may not exceed one 10 month.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits a landlord from collecting rent more than 3 months in advance of the date the rent is actually due.
