SENATE AMENDMENT "#" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 16 1116, L.D. 1559, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in that part designated 20 "**§1956.**" in the first paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "<u>A holder</u>" 22 the following: '<u>of accounts on deposit at a financial</u> <u>organization</u>'

Amend the amendment on page 2 in that part designated "**§1956.**" in the first paragraph in the next to the last line (page 2, line 38 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "canceled." the following: '<u>A holder who is not a financial</u> organization is prohibited from deducting an amount for a charge 30 <u>due to dormancy.</u>'

32 Further amend the amendment on page 3 by inserting before the first indented paragraph the following:

'MAINE COMMENT

Section 1956 limits the holders who are allowed to deduct a dormancy charge to only financial organizations, as defined in section 1952, subsection 5. All other holders are expressly prohibited from deducting an amount for a dormancy charge.'
