## **'FISCAL NOTE**

The additional costs associated with a study of charter 4 schools and school choice initiatives can be absorbed by the 5 State Board of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 6

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the original resolve and directs the State Board of Education to establish a committee to study charter schools and school choice initiatives in other states and jurisdictions. In conducting its study, the board's committee shall meet at least 4 times and shall report its findings and any recommended legislation to the Legislature by January 1, 1998.
