28	A person possessing a valid fishing license whom the
30	commissioner determines is not able to use a fly rod due to a physical disability is eligible to have a stamp affixed to that
32	license at no cost authorizing that person to fish using a rod and reel with a single line, a bobber and a fly in waters open to
34	fishing that are designated by the commissioner as fly-fishing only waters.

42	This bill allows a person who is not able to use a fly rod due to a physical disability to fish in fly-fishing only waters
