

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §8711, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

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3. Information on providers. The organization shall collect data identified by providers on rates of morbidity, infection, mortality and surgery. This information must be made available to the public on request, notwithstanding section 8707.

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SUMMARY

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This bill requires the Maine Health Data Organization to collect and make public data identified by providers on rates of morbidity, infection, mortality and surgery.
