SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1133, L.D. 1589, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Composition of the Information Services Policy Board and Establish a Clearinghouse on State Information and Information Technology"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 8 in the 5th line (page 4, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "November 15" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 1'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 3. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

10 The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill.  
11 General Fund appropriations are reduced by \$1,260 in fiscal year  
12 1998-99 leaving a General Fund appropriation in fiscal year  
13 1997-98 only of \$840.

14 The amendment also limits the staffing responsibility of the  
15 Legislature by requiring that the study be completed during the  
16 interim between sessions.
