20 Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 8 in the 5th line (page 4, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the 22 following: "November 15" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 1'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

10	The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill. General Fund appropriations are reduced by \$1,260 in fiscal year
12	1998-99 leaving a General Fund appropriation in fiscal year 1997-98 only of \$840.
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16	The amendment also limits the staffing responsibility of the Legislature by requiring that the study be completed during the interim between sessions.
