SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 519, L.D. 1603, "Resolve, to Foster Economic Growth through the Recognition and Development of Maine's Franco-American Resource"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title and before the indented paragraph before the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 7th and 8th paragraphs (page 1, lines 37 to 47 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 1 to 10 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$6,850 in fiscal year 1997-98 by striking the sections that authorized the Commission to Study the Development of Maine's Franco-American Resource.

The amendment also eliminates the minor costs that would have accrued to the Legislature and the University of Maine to provide staffing and clerical assistance to the commission.
