for the Maine Franco-American Center at the University of Maine for the costs of its participation with the commission.

4 The additional costs associated with providing staffing and clerical assistance to the commission can be absorbed by the 6 Legislature and the University of Maine System utilizing existing budgeted resources.

This resolve includes an Other Special Revenue allocation to 10 the Legislature of \$500 in fiscal year 1997-98 as a base allocation to authorize expenditures in the event that outside 12 sources of funding are received to support the commission.

14 The University of Maine System, the Maine Technical College System and the Department of Economic and Community Development 16 will incur some minor additional costs to participate as members 18 of the commission. These costs can be absorbed within the 18 respective agencies' existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to appoint a designee to serve on the Commission to Study the Development of Maine's Franco-American Resource and also provides that the Maine Franco-American Center at the University of Maine and the Legislative Council staff will provide staffing jointly to the commission. This amendment also adds an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
