HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 520, L.D. 1604, Bill, "An Act to Revise Certain Provisions of Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 15-A by striking out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in their place the following:

'A. Firearms of any type that are permitted under the laws governing hunting, including muzzle-loading firearms; or

B. Archery equipment that is permitted under the hunting laws governing archery, including, but not limited to, recurved bows and compound bows.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the definition of hunting equipment includes only that equipment that is permitted under the hunting laws.
