

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2677 is enacted to read:

6 **§2677. Health insurance; retired officers**

8 Notwithstanding section 2671, a municipality shall keep a
10 retired municipal employee formerly employed by the municipality
12 in that municipality's health care plan as long as the retired
14 employee continues to pay the health insurance premiums required
16 for that retired employee.

18 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill requires a municipality to allow a retired former
22 employee to continue to stay enrolled in the municipality's
24 health insurance plan if the retired employee pays the premiums.
