## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §13796 is enacted to read:

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§13796. Prohibited disclosures of prescribing practices

A pharmacist, health maintenance organization, insurance 8 company or pharmaceutical wholesaler may not provide a pharmaceutical company, for marketing purposes, with information 10 concerning the prescribing practices of any practitioner.

## SUMMARY

16 This bill prohibits pharmacists, health maintenance organizations, insurance companies or pharmaceutical wholesalers 18 from giving information used for marketing purposes to drug companies about the prescribing practices of physicians and 20 others who can lawfully prescribe drugs.
