COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1145, L.D. 1610, "Resolve, to Establish a Commission to Designate Outstanding Maine Citizens Whose Portraits Are to Be Displayed in the State House"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '8'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Education and Cultural Affairs" and inserting in its place the following: 'State and Local Government'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 5 in the last line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "be it further"

Further amend the resolve in section 2 by adding after subsection 5 the following:

'6. One representative from the State House and Capitol Park Commission, appointed by the director; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the last line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "extension." and inserting in its place the following: 'extension; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$2,425 in fiscal year 1997-98 for the per diem of the legislative member, expenses for members and miscellaneous costs, including printing, of the Commission on Outstanding Citizens. The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the commission can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Office of the Governor and the Maine State Museum will incur some minor additional costs to participate as members of the commission. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.'

The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
