Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

The Board of Occupational Therapy Practice within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor additional costs to revise certain rules. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the definitions of certified occupational therapy assistant and occupational therapist in the original bill. The new definitions remove the requirement that an individual be in "good standing" with the National Board of Certification in Occupational Therapy. This amendment also allows the board to renew a temporary license one time for a person who has failed the examination. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
