Public Law 1997, chapter 24 includes allocations of \$1,253,233 in 2 fiscal year 1997-98 and \$1,267,531 in fiscal year 1998-99 based the continuation of the current surcharge through the 4 1998-1999 biennium. Raising the monthly statewide E - 9 - 1 - 1surcharge from 20 cents to 32 cents beginning August 1, 1998 will б increase dedicated revenue to the Department of Public Safety by an additional \$861,490 in fiscal year 1998-99. An Other Special Revenue allocation to the Department of Public Safety of \$861,490 8 in fiscal year 1998-99 is included to authorize the expenditure 10 of the additional dedicated revenue for the installation of E-9-1-1 equipment and ongoing maintenance costs. 12 The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system 14 can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial 16 Department.
