## SUMMARY

This amendment makes 2 changes to the resolve. It requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to consider both roadside testing and annual testing at the time of inspection of heavy duty diesel-powered vehicles when developing a proposal for a motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program. It also requires the commissioner to make a recommendation on the feasibility of including in any new motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program a method of providing credits toward the program requirements to motor vehicle owners who incurred costs under the repealed emission inspection program. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
