SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1174, L.D. 1651, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Environmental Protection to Study and Make Recommendations on the Establishment of a Motor Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance Program to Meet the Requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '1'

Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 30 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "with" the following: 'a 5-member subcommittee of'

Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "at least" and inserting in its place the following: 'no more than'

Further amend the resolve in section 4 in the last line (page 2, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 4 the following:

**'Sec. 5. Budget authorization. Resolved:** That the Legislature's existing budgeted resources must be utilized for the per diem and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for each day's attendance of the subcommittee at meetings authorized in section 3.'
