HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1654, Bill, "An Act to Allow Agricultural Workers to Bargain Collectively"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Extend Collective Bargaining Rights to Employees of Large Industrial Agricultural Operations'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 28 to 31 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1322.~~" in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 10 to 13 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: "Agricultural employer" is limited to a person or entity operating an egg processing facility that has over 300,000 laying birds and that employs more than 75 agricultural employees as defined in subsection 2.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill title and limits the application of the bill to egg processing facilities that have
