HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1654, Bill, "An Act to Allow Agricultural Workers to Bargain Collectively"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1324." in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph F (page 3, lines 30 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'F. Locking out their employees; and'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1324." in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 4, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1324." in subsection 2 in paragraph E in the last line (page 4, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1324." in subsection 2 by inserting at the end the following:

'F. Causing or attempting to cause or participating in a strike against their employer.'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits agricultural employers governed by the bill from locking out their employees and prohibits their employees from striking.
