2	Sec. 1. P&SL 1899, c. 46, §8 is repealed.
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6	Sec. 2. P&SL 1899, c. 46, §9, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1933, c. 15, is amended to read:
8	Sec. 9. May hold property. The said corporation for all its said purposes may hold real and personal estate in such an
10	amount as-shall-be-necessary-and-convenient-for-the-conduct-of its-business not to exceed \$1,000,000.

14	Section 10. The said corporation may issue its bonds for

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	Sec. 4. P&SL 1899, c. 46, §§11-A to 11-D are enacted to read:
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	Section 11-A. Nonprofit status. Hebron Water Company, upon
24	approval of its sole shareholder, has the authority to convert
	its status from a for-profit business corporation to a nonprofit
26	corporation, the conversion to be effected by filing with the
	Secretary of State an amendment to the corporation's articles of
28	incorporation. The amendment must provide that the corporation
	retains its original incorporation date of February 21, 1899 and
30	retains all of its rights, powers, duties, authorities,
	privileges and obligations as now exist. Upon filing of the
32	amendment all outstanding shares of the corporation's stock are
	canceled and the corporation's status automatically converts into
34	that of a nonprofit corporation governed by the Maine Revised

2 Section 11-D. Form of amendment. The board of directors, acting through the corporation's officers, has authority to file the amendment authorized under section 11-A in a form it 4 determines appropriate and to make further amendments to the articles of incorporation consistent with this Act. 6

SUMMARY

The purpose of this bill is to allow the Hebron Water Company to convert to a nonprofit water company. The bill also increases the debt limit of the water company to \$1,000,000.
