HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 553, L.D. 1679, Bill, "An Act to Assist the Law Enforcement Community in Locating Missing Children"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2154-A." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "received" and inserting in its place the following: 'receives'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2154-A." in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "receiving" and inserting in its place the following: 'that receives'
