Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §13183, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 395, Pt. A, §212, is amended to read:

6 §13183. Acts authorized

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8 An agency, through its designated broker, may perform all of the brokerage services contemplated by this chapter and may employ or retain others to perform brokerage services on behalf 10 of the agency. The designated broker may also delegate any of his the designated broker's duties and authority provided for under 12 this chapter, but when doing so shall is not be relieved of any responsibility imposed by this chapter. A designated broker may 14 delegate duties and authority to a subagent who is the subagent of another designated broker with the approval of the other 16 designated broker. For purposes of this section, "subagent" has the same meaning as in section 13271, subsection 12. 18

SUMMARY

This bill permits a designated real estate broker to 24 delegate duties and authority to a subagent who is the subagent of another designated broker with the approval of the other 26 designated broker.
