24	by inserting after the following: " <u>processing</u> ." the following: ' <u>A</u> person who sells or offers for sale alewives smoked with the
26	viscera shall post a clearly legible sign at the point of display of the alewives that states, "This product is not fully cooked.
2 8	Eating prior to fully cooking poses a health risk." '

34	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It requires a person selling alewives smoked with their viscera to
36	post a sign advising consumers to cook them prior to eating.
