	1. Maximum towing charges. The maximum charge for removing
8	a vehicle from a wrecker or tow truck is \$20. A vehicle may not
	be considered to be on a tow truck or wrecker and no charge may
10	be assessed if all the vehicle's wheels are on the ground. The
	maximum charge for towing a vehicle is \$60.

	2. Maximum storage charge. The maximum charge for storage
14	of a vehicle is \$15 per day.
