HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 560, L.D. 1693, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Health Data Organization Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes the collection of Other Special Revenue by the Maine Health Data Organization from assessments on certain health care providers and insurers, generating up to \$639,000 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$651,000 in fiscal year 1998-99. Additional dedicated revenue may also be generated from user fees and interest income. Public Law 1997, chapter 24 includes Other Special Revenue allocations of \$637,721 and \$650,912 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively, for the Maine Health Data Organization authorizing the expenditure of this Other Special Revenue.

Dedicating the interest earnings on the Maine Health Data Organization's dedicated account will result in reductions of General Fund revenue from interest earnings on the Treasurer's cash pool. The amounts can not be estimated at this time.

The new assessment on insurers may have an insignificant impact on the state employee health insurance program as it will
