HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1216, L.D. 1716, Bill, "An Act to Establish Family Development Accounts"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§1079.~~" by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 7, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Compensation. Members of the committee who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the committee. Other members serve without reimbursement for expenses.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides for reimbursement for Legislators serving on the Advisory Committee on Family Development Accounts.
