An Act Regarding Appointment to the Maine Public Broadcasting Board of Trustees.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. PL 1991, c. 848, §3 is amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

On January 1, 1998, the Board of Trustees of the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation must consist of the following members: the chancellor of the University of Maine System; 3 members who are members of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System; the President of Bates College; the President of Bowdoin College; the President of Colby College; and 8 public trustees appointed by the Governor, 4 of whom are residents of this State's first congressional district and 4 of whom are residents of this State's 2nd congressional district. Insofar as it is feasible, when appointing public trustees, the Governor shall consider affirmative action criteria and professional education and experience. The President of the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation may not be a member of the board. By January 1, 1998, the board shall amend the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation bylaws to reflect the composition and method of appointment of board members described in this paragraph.

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#### **SUMMARY**

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This bill alters the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation. It requires the Governor to appoint 8 public trustees and prohibits the President of the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation from serving on the board.
