removes the need for additional General Fund appropriations for the department beginning in fiscal year 1998-99.

4 The department will incur some minor additional costs to submit a required report to the Legislature pertaining to certain 6 recommendations received from municipalities. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

The Land Use Regulation Commission within the Department of Conservation may incur some minor additional costs to approve any recommendations pertaining to the regulation of watercraft on great ponds within its jurisdiction. These costs can be absorbed within the commission's existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

18 This amendment strikes out those sections of the committee amendment that regulate the operation of personal watercraft and 20 expand the authority of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to regulate surface water uses and replaces them with a 22 prohibition on operating watercraft with a horsepower of 40 or greater on any great pond under 200 acres.
