SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 573, L.D. 1730, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Great Pond Task Force"

Amend the amendment in section 8 in that part designated "~~§7825-B.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the last line (page 5, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or"

Further amend the amendment in section 8 in that part designated "~~§7825-B.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph C in the last line (page 5, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; or'

Further amend the amendment in section 8 in that part designated "~~§7825-B.~~" in subsection 4 by inserting at the end the following:

'D. A property owner who offers a person renting or leasing that property the use of a motorboat registered to the property owner.'

FISCAL NOTE

Exempting certain property owners from licensing requirements as a motorboat rental and leasing agent will result in insignificant reductions of General Fund revenue from license fees.
