SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 579, L.D. 1744, Bill, "An Act to Establish Acute Crisis Stabilization Beds for Children in this State"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 4th line (page 2, line 42 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "with a" the following: '3-member'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 by inserting at the end the following: 'The subcommittee may not meet more than 4 times; and be it further;'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 3 the following:

**Sec. 4. Reimbursement. Resolved:** That the legislative subcommittee is entitled to receive, upon application to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council, the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at progress report meetings; and be it further

**Sec. 5. Appropriation. Resolved:** That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
