Further amend the amendment in section 3 by inserting at the 24 end the following: 'The subcommittee may not meet more than 4 times; and be it further;'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the legislative subcommittee is entitled to receive, upon application to the
Executive Director of the Legislative Council, the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3,
section 2, and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at progress report meetings; and be it
