14 SUMMARY

16 This amendment makes the following changes to the resolve. The resolve authorizes the Land and Water Resources Council to 18 seek the advice and support of certain groups in developing a long-range strategy to evaluate and reduce mercury contamination 20 in Maine's environment. The amendment requires the council to seek the advice and support of Legislators as well as those 22 groups. The amendment requires the council to report its initial evaluation and recommendations as part of its January, 1998 24 annual report. The amendment also gives the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources authority to report 26 legislation regarding the reduction of mercury emissions and discharges to the Second Regular Session of the 118th 28 Legislature. The amendment also makes a technical correction and adds a fiscal note to the resolve.

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
