COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 583, L.D. 1746, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Relating to Development and Centralized Listing of Municipal Ordinances That Apply to Forest Practices"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 8 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1999" and inserting in its place the following: '2000'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Conservation will require a future General Fund appropriation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 1999-2000 for data base updating costs. The Department of Conservation will also require future additional annual General Fund appropriations of \$15,000 beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000 to provide full reimbursement for a state mandate that requires municipalities to revise certain municipal ordinances and provide certain notifications.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. This amendment changes the date by which municipal ordinances must comply with a standard for definitions. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
