HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 584, L.D. 1747, Bill, "An Act to Improve Transportation in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in that part designated "§1171-B." in subsection 1 in paragraph C by striking out all of the last sentence (page 3, lines 24 to 26 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in that part designated "§1171-B." by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

'6. Application. Unless otherwise provided by law, a license issued under this section is governed by the provisions of this section and rules adopted by the Secretary of State that are in effect during the term of the license.'

Further amend the amendment in section 12 in paragraph 1 in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the first line (page 8, line 49 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "may" the following: 'not'


SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that manufacturer licenses issued under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 1171-B are subject to that section and rules adopted pursuant to that section in effect throughout the term of the license. This amendment also corrects a typographical error and clarifies that
