COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1232, L.D. 1749, "Resolve, Authorizing the Department of Transportation to Erect Signs Identifying the World War II Memorial in Bangor"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Designating a World War II Monument in Bangor an Official State Memorial and Authorizing the Department of Transportation to Erect Signs Identifying That Memorial'

Further amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Designating an official state memorial in honor of World War II veterans. Resolved: That the monument to be erected in Bangor on the grounds of the Cole Land Transportation Museum be designated an official state memorial to honor the veterans of Maine who gave their lives in defense of freedom during World War II; and be it further

Sec. 2. Signs for World War II memorial. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation may erect signs in appropriate locations identifying the location of the World War II memorial designated under section 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

The additional costs associated with erecting signs for a World War II Memorial in Bangor can be absorbed by the Department of Transportation utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

The amendment replaces the resolve. It designates as an official state memorial the World War II monument to be erected in Bangor on the grounds of the Cole Land Transportation Museum. It also authorizes the Department of Transportation to erect signs identifying the memorial's location.
