The bill made various changes to the Licensure Act for Speech Pathologists and Audiologists that included a new definition for "speech-language pathology assistant" and requirements for qualification of a "speech-language pathology assistant." The credential of "speech-language pathology aide" would terminate by 2005 and a person could not apply for this credential after December 31, 1997.

The amendment strikes the provision that a person may not apply for the credential of "speech-language pathology aide" after December 31, 1997. The amendment requires that a person applying for that credential after October 1, 1997 must demonstrate 2 years of post-secondary education and submit a training speech-language plan endorsed by a licensed pathologist. The amendment also adds language that requires all speech-language pathology aides to meet the eligibility requirements for a speech-language pathology assistant by January 1, 2005 in order to continue their practice of speech-language pathology.

The amendment also changes the rules that pertain to the speech-language pathology assistant credential from major substantive rules to routine technical rules. Technical wording changes are also made. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
