2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6501, sub-§8** is enacted to read:

6 **8. Shrimp season.** It is illegal to take shrimp under this section except from February 1st to March 31st.
