'FISCAL NOTE

18 The Bureau of Taxation will incur some minor additional costs to serve as a full member of the Multistate Tax Commission and administer the Multistate Tax Compact Advisory Committee. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted 22 resources.

24 The additional costs associated with participating on the Multistate Tax Compact Advisory Committee can be absorbed by the 26 Department of the Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources.

This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional filing fees may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes technical changes and adds a fiscal 40 note to the bill.
