COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1254, L.D. 1781, Bill, "An Act to Create the Maine Scholarship Lottery Game"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

 The bill will also reduce dedicated revenue to the Outdoor
 Heritage Fund by \$80,518 and \$122,770 in fiscal years 1997-98 and
 1998-99, respectively.

 18 Dedicated revenue to the Maine Student Incentive Scholarship
 Program is estimated to be \$688,803 and \$935,800 in fiscal years
 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. These amounts must be
 20 allocated to authorize expenditures. Any new incremental sales
 that may result are expected to be insignificant.'
