2	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1102, sub-§1, ¶¶L and M, as enacted by PL
4	1989, c. 924, §3, are amended to read:
6	L. Lysergic acid; and
8	M. Lysergic acid amider; and
10	Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §1102, sub-§1, ¶N is enacted to read:
12	N. Flunitrazepam or its chemical equivalent.

18	This bill specifically names Flunitrazepam as a scheduled drug in schedule W thereby allowing the introduction of a laboratory analysis certificate into evidence under the Maine
20	Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 1112. This bill schedules Flunitrazepam as a scheduled W drug rather than another schedule
22	because of its ability to incapacitate its consumer, and its illegal street use on unsuspecting and nonconsenting sexual
24	assault victims. This bill is not intended to affect in any way the current or future, scheduling, licensure or otherwise
26	legitimate use of Flunitrazepam under federal or state law.
