## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

 Sec. 2. Funding of programs. The Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services shall distribute
\$89,000 among the Kennebec Alliance, School Administrative District No. 15, the Kittery School Department and the University
of Maine at Presque Isle to be used for the funding of services for at-risk students and their families.
