Sec. 2. Statewide meeting. Resolved: That the Commissioner of 8 Education shall conduct, no later than November 1, 1997, a statewide meeting on alternative school calendars that includes 10 educators throughout the State; and be it further

12 Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Education shall report any findings and recommendations, including any legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs, no later than January 15, 1998.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 18 summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

22 The additional costs associated with developing plans for an alternative school calendar can be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

The amendment replaces the original bill and directs the 30 Commissioner of Education to establish plans for an alternative school calendar for local schools that are interested in an 32 alternative school calendar and directs the commissioner to hold meeting on issue of alternative school а statewide the 34 The amendment requires the commissioner to report calendars. back to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural 36 Affairs no later than January 15, 1998.
