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#### STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 118TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1277, L.D. 1807, Bill, "An Act to Provide for Commitment of Sexually Violent Predators"

22 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Create a Program for the Control, Care and Treatment of Sexually Violent Predators'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

32 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
34 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

36 Whereas, the Legislature finds there exists an extremely dangerous group of sexually violent predators who have a mental abnormality or personality disorder and who have a significant likelihood to engage in repeated acts of sexual violence unless 40 the State provides an effective intervention mechanism; and

42 Whereas, the Legislature finds that the current criminal justice system inadequately addresses the special needs of 44 sexually violent predators and the risks they present to society; and

Whereas, the Legislature finds that there is an urgent need for a program that provides for the control, care and treatment of sexually violent predators; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved: That the Commission to Implement a Program for the Control, Care and Treatment of Sexually Violent Predators, referred to in this resolve as the "commission," be established; and be it further

Sec. 2. Membership. Resolved: That the commission consist of 13 members appointed as follows.

1. The President of the Senate shall appoint 3 members from the Senate who either serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary or the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice or who are interested in developing a program for the control, care and treatment of sexually violent offenders. The first Senate member named is the Senate Chair.

The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
appoint 10 members from the House of Representatives who either serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary or the Joint
Standing Committee on Criminal Justice or who are interested in developing a program for the control, care and treatment of
sexually violent offenders. The first House member named is the House Chair; and be it further

Sec. 3. Appointments. Resolved: That all appointments must be 32 made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive 34 Legislative Council upon making Director of the their appointments. When the appointment of all members is complete, 36 the chairs of the commission shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission no later than May 15, 1998; and be it 3.8 further

Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: 40 That the commission shall develop a plan to implement a program to provide for the control, care and 42 treatment of sexually violent predators. The plan must include a description of proposed facilities, at least the following: 44 appropriate treatment modalities, personnel requirements, legal and practical procedures for using the program, an estimate of 46 the population of sexually violent predators that would be eligible to participate in the program and costs and funding 48 estimates. In developing the plan, the commission shall:

Seek input from the Department of Corrections, the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, the Judicial Department and other state agencies; 4 Examine programs for the control, care and treatment of б 2. sexually violent predators in other jurisdictions; 8 3. Review legal parameters applicable to such programs; 10 Examine the financial implications of program options; 4. 12 5. sexually violent Review the potential predator population estimates; and 14 16 6. Invite the participation of experts and interested parties; and be it further 18 Sec. 5. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the commission shall request staffing and clerical assistance from the Legislative 20 Council; and be it further 22 Sec. 6. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the commission members are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in 24 the Maine Revised Statute's, Title 3, section 2, for each day's

attendance at meetings of the commission and reimbursement for 26 travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the commission. The Executive Director of the Legislative 28 Council shall administer the commission's budget; and be it 30 further

32 Sec. 7. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit its report with any accompanying legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary by October 15, 1998. If the 34 commission requires an extension of time to make its report, it 36 may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension; and be it further 38

Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 40 this resolve. 42

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study commission to develop a plan for the control, care and treatment of sexually violent predators. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives will appoint the members from the Senate and House and select the cochairs. The commission will report to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary by October 15, 1998; the Legislative Council may extend the reporting date.

The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
