

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 623, L.D. 1826, Bill, "An Act to Change the Name of the Bureau of Taxation and to Allow Other Agencies of the State to Benefit from Its Services"

Amend the bill in section 3 in the last line (page 2, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "." the following: 'An agreement may not take effect without prior approval of the arrangement from the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires any arrangement between the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the State Tax Assessor to include hunting and fishing licenses in state individual income tax booklets to first be approved by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters.
