
HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 623, L.D. 1826, Bill, "An Act to Change the Name of the Bureau of Taxation and to Allow Other Agencies of the State to Benefit from Its Services"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes the authority of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to enter into an arrangement with the State Tax Assessor to include fishing and hunting licenses in state individual income tax booklets.
